Spring 2019 Executive Election

By serving in the role of Deputy Electoral Officer (DEO) for the Spring 2019 Executive Election, the undersigned hereby acknowledge that they have met the following eligibility requirements:

- They are 18 years of age or older at the time of their appointment;
- They disqualify themselves from running as a Candidate in the Spring 2019 Executive Election;
- They retain their right to cast a ballot and to vote for any Candidate(s) they choose;

Furthermore, the undersigned hereby acknowledge and affirm/swear to uphold the following rules and regulations:

- They swear to follow and enforce the Electoral Code, as defined in Article VIII of the CU FIRST Constitution;
- They swear to follow and enforce the Code of Conduct, as defined in Article IV of the CU FIRST Constitution;
- They swear to be a neutral and impartial party, never showing favour to any particular candidate while exercising their duties;
- They swear to uphold the integrity of the elections process, counting and recording all votes equally and fairly;
- They swear maintain the secrecy of each vote:
