Furthermore, the undersigned hereby acknowledge and affirm/swear to uphold the following rules and regulations:

- They swear to follow and enforce the Electoral Code, as defined in Article VIII of the CU FIRST Constitution;
- They swear to follow and enforce the Code of Conduct, as defined in Article IV of the CU FIRST Constitution;
- They swear to be a neutral and impartial party, never showing favour to any particular candidate while exercising their duties;
- They swear to uphold the integrity of the elections process, counting and recording all votes equally and fairly;
- They swear maintain the secrecy of each vote;
